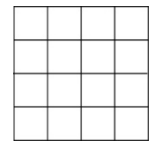
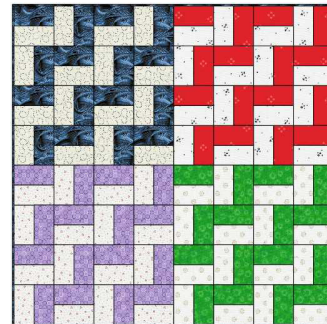
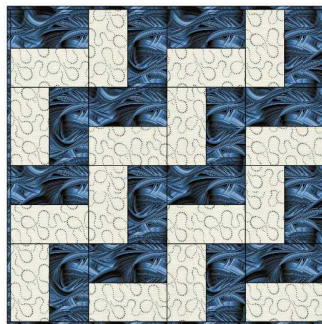


Rail Fence Ripple
Rotary Cutting or AccuQuilt
Four Block Sizes
6, 8, 12 and 16" Finished

4 x 4 Grid

For 6" Finished Block

This block is cut from fat quarters and strip pieced. From 1 light FQ + 1 dark FQ, you can make up to 8 blocks.

For 1 block you need:

- 2 light strips @ 1-1/4" x 18"
- 2 dark strips @ 1-1/4" x 18"

From 1 light and 1 dark fat quarter you can get up to 8 blocks.

AccuQuilt

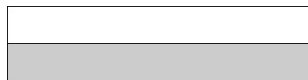
Use 55109 – 1-1/4" strip cutter to cut strips and the 2" strip cutter to cut the rail fence segments.

Designed by Becky Cogan for Need'I Love, this block is part of a free quilt pattern available from AllPeopleQuilt.com. The quilt finished approx. 54" x 72" and is fat quarter friendly. Click or scan the code to download.

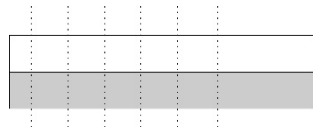


To make 1 block from fat quarters:

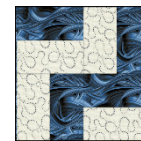
1. Using the 2 light and 2 dark strips, make 2 strip sets. Sew 1 light and 1 dark strip together along the long side. Make 2 Press seams.



2. Sub cut each strip set into 8 @ 2" segments for a total of 16 rail fence units.



3. Using 4 rail fence units, make the corner unit.



Make 4 corner units

4. Refer to diagram to assemble block.

Other Strip/Block Sizes

*For AccuQuilt use corresponding strip cutters

*Strip Size (in)	*Cut Segments (in)	Finished Block Size (in)	# of Light and Dark WOF Strips
1-1/2	2-1/2	8	1 strip of each = 2 blocks
2	3-1/2	12	2 strips of each = 3 blocks
2-1/2	4-1/2	16	2 strips of each = 2 blocks
