

MAKING WAVES QUILT INSTRUCTIONS Rotary Cutting or AccuQuilt

There is no curved piecing at all in this quilt! The design and use of fabric just makes it look that way. One block in two colorways is all it is.

Fabric Requirements


These are the fabrics used in the sample. There is a blank chart on the last page. Use that chart to glue swatches of your fabric.




Units

There is one block with two colorings in this quilt. The images below show the exploded view of the two colorings.



Dark Block - Make 15



Light Block - Make 15

The Square in Square and Half square triangle units are the only units colored the same in each block.

Cutting Instructions

If you want to be really organized, you will need 2 @ jumbo plastic zip bags and 12 @ one gallon plastic zip bags. The cheap ones are perfect. I have bags that I've used repeatedly.

Mark the jumbo bags "Light Block" and "Dark Block". Six of the smaller bags will go into the Light bag and 6 into the Dark bag. Label the 6 smaller bags as:

Light Bag	Dark Bag
LT 4 Patch	DK 4 Patch
LT Squares	DK Squares
LT HST	DK HST
LT Tri Rec In	DK Tri Rec In
LT Tri Rec Out	LT Tri Rec Out
LT Square In	DK Square In

These labels correspond to the units shown at left.

Start with your Fabric 1. The instructions will tell you what to cut and which bag to put them in. After all the cutting is complete, the piecing can begin.



Fabric 1 - Black Tone on Tone

- Cut 6 strips @ 2" x WOF. Place 6 in Light bag – 4-patch
- Cut 3 @ 7-3/4" x WOF. Sub cut to 15 @ 7-3/4" squares.
 - Place 8 in Light bag HST.
 - o Place 7 in Dark bag HST.
 - After piecing the HST, 60 will go in the Light bag and 60 in the Dark bag.
- Cut 2 @ 2-5/8" x WOF. Sub cut to 30 @ 2-5/8" squares.
 - Place 15 in Light bag Square in Square.
 - Place 15 in Dark bag Square in Square.

Fabric 2 - White Low Volume Print

- Cut 12 @ 2" x WOF.
 - Place 6 in Light bag 4-patch.
 - Place 6 in Dark bag 4-patch.
- Cut 3 @ 7-3/4" x WOF. Sub cut to 15 @ 7-3/4" squares.
 - Place 8 in Light bag HST.
 - Place 7 in Dark bag HST.
- Cut 8 @ 3.5" x WOF.
 - With wrong sides together and using the rectangle part of the Tri Rec rulers, sub cut 120 Rec pairs.
 - Place 60 pairs in Light bag Tri Rec in.
 - Place 60 pairs in Light bag Tri Recout.
- Cut 4 @ 3.5 x WOF.
 - Using the triangle part of the Tri Rec rulers, sub cut 60 triangles.
 - Place in Dark bag Tri Rec out.

Fabric 3 – Light Brown

- Cut 10 @ 3.5" x WOF. Sub cut 120 @ 3.5" squares. Place in Light bag – Squares.
- Cut 8 @ 3.5" x WOF.
 - Using the triangle part of the Tri Rec rulers, sub cut 120 triangles.
 - o Place 60 in Light bag Tri Rec in.
 - Place 60 in Dark bag Tri Rec in.

Fabric 4 - Medium Brown

 Cut 10 @ 3.5" x WOF. Sub cut 120 @ 3.5" squares. Place in Dark bag – Squares.

Fabric 5 - Dark Brown

- Cut 4 @ 3.5" x WOF.
 - With wrong sides together and using the rectangle part of the Tri Rec rulers, sub cut 60 Rec pairs.
 - o Place in Dark bag Tri Rec out.

Fabric 6 – Light Silver Grey

- Cut 4 @ 2-3/8" x WOF
 - Sub cut to 60 @ 2-3/8" squares.
 - Cut each square in half once diagonally to make 120 triangles.
 - Place 60 triangles in Dark bag Square in Square.
 - Place 60 triangles in Light bag –
 Square in Square



Fabric 7 - Dark Silver Grey

- Cut 6 @ 2" x WOF.
 - o Place in Dark bag 4-patch
- Cut 4 @ 3.5" x WOF.
 - Using the triangle part of the Tri Rec rulers, sub cut 60 triangles.
 - o Place in Light bag Tri Rec out.
- Cut 4 @ 3.5" x WOF.
 - With wrong sides together and using the rectangle part of the Tri Rec rulers, sub cut 60 Rec pairs.
 - Place in Dark bag Tri Rec in.

Piecing

Piece one bag at a time!

4-Patch

 Sew 1 light and 1 dark fabric together along the length.



Make 6

 Stack one strip set, right sides together on top of another. Interlock the seams




Make 3

• Sub cut into 60 @ 2" segments.



 Stitch each segment together to make a 4patch unit.




Make 60

Place 4-patches back in bag.

Half Square Triangles - HST

Use the Eight at A Time method to piece the half square triangles.

- 1. On the wrong side of Fabric 2, draw two diagonal lines shown in red.
- 2. Place one Fabric 1 and one Fabric 2, right sides together.
- 3. Stitch on both sides of each diagonal line shown as dashed lines.
- 4. Cut on the diagonal lines in red and the horizontal and vertical lines in blue.



5. Place 60 HST in TL HST and 60 HST in DK HST.




Tri Rec In and Tri Rec Out

Following the instructions for the Tri Rec Ruler, piece all the tri rec units. Place the completed units back into their respective bags.


Square In Square

Sew a triangle to opposite sides of the square.



Press toward triangle.

Sew a triangle to each of the remaining sides of the square.




Make 15

Assemble the Blocks

Using the diagrams on page 2, assemble the light and dark blocks. You will make 15 of each.

Assemble the Top

Alternate the light and dark blocks as shown below to complete the quilt top.
